



# Above the Barre Responsible Restart

Employees	
<b>Training/Gym Preparation</b>	All employees are required to attend training on ATB's protocol for safety. Coaches will set up their lesson plans to minimize touchpoints and keep social distancing.
<b>Employee Health Checks</b>	Employees will take their temperature and sign-off from a self-assessment checklist at the start of each shift.
<b>PPE Standards</b>	Employees are required to wear face coverings when in common areas and within six feet of students/co-workers.
<b>Social Distancing</b>	Employees must maintain a six-foot distance from other staff members and students/parents unless instruction makes it impractical.
<b>Personal Sanitization</b>	Hands will be sanitized upon entering the building and between events. Disinfectant wipes will be available inside the gym.
<b>Communication</b>	Staff will meet regularly to discuss best practices of protocol and to report any incidents/concerns. Updates will be sent to families when appropriate.
<b>Attendance</b>	Attendance will continue to be taken daily should contact tracing be necessary.

Facility	
<b>Sanitation of Facility</b>	The entire facility has been professionally deep cleaned and treated with Enviroshield. Our cleaning company, JanPro, will continue nightly professional cleanings. A daytime janitor is now on staff until guidelines suggest otherwise.
<b>Removal of Touchpoints</b>	Fewer things in the gym mean fewer things for people to touch.
<b>Event Rotations in the Gym</b>	Markings on the floor, such as X's and lines, visually establish social distancing standards. Preassigned personal spaces around the perimeter of the gym for gymnastics bags will be labeled. All doors will remain open when possible to reduce touchpoints. Outside doors should remain open, weather permitting, to provide fresh air.
<b>Sanitation Stations</b>	Sanitation dispensers are available throughout the facility.
<b>Snacks</b>	The snack station has been removed temporarily. Bottled water will continue to be available for purchase in the gym. Water sales can only be handled by the instructor until further notice.
<b>Customer Service Station</b>	Plexiglass barriers have been hung at the front desk. Customer service will be available on-site with limited hours.
<b>Water Fountains</b>	Water fountains have been disabled until guidelines suggest otherwise.

<b>Students</b>	
<b>Arrival</b>	Students will not be permitted to enter the building more than 10 minutes before their practice.
<b>Temperature Checks</b>	Students will line up according to social distancing standards. Before entering the building, temperatures will be checked until further notice. If the temperature is equal to or exceeds 100.4°F, they will be sent home. If the student or a family member is exhibiting flu-like symptoms, the student will be required to stay home.
<b>Personal Sanitation</b>	Hands will be sanitized when entering the building, and upon exiting and in-between events. The instructor can request that a student sanitizes for the good of all the students at any time they feel necessary.
<b>Gymnastics Bag</b>	Students may bring only 1 item/bag into the facility. Contents of the bag must include grips (if they use them), personal chalk box/bag (if family prefers to use personal chalk), water bottle, personal sanitizer, face covering, and a snack.
<b>Attire</b>	Restrooms <b>will not</b> be available for changing, please arrive dressed for practice. Female gymnasts must wear a leotard and have the option of wearing spandex shorts. Male gymnasts must wear a shirt with athletic shorts.
<b>Face Coverings</b>	Face coverings are recommended when entering and exiting through the common areas of the building unless there are underlying medical exceptions. Once a gymnast is inside the gym it is the discretion of the students family if it is worn. For the safety of our students, a face covering is not recommended while they are practicing inside the gym.
<b>Event Rotation</b>	Numbers will be assigned to each student that correspond with their personal space in the gym. When rotating between events, students will be dismissed to their personal space. Students will be asked to sanitize hands between each event while waiting for the coach to set up the next event stations. Students will be called to the event once the instructor is ready to begin.
<b>Social Distancing</b>	Social distancing standards between students will be strictly enforced. There will be markings on the floor, such as X's and lines, visually enabling students to be mindful of spacing.
<b>Use of Restrooms</b>	Students will only be allowed to exit the gym if they need to use the restroom. Sanitation of hands is required upon reentry to the gym.
<b>Bodily Fluids on Surfaces</b>	If for any reason the class needs to pause due to bodily fluids, such as spit, students will be directed to the sanitation station before practice can proceed.
<b>Exiting the Facility</b>	Students will be directed to collect their belongings and exit the building while maintaining social distancing standards. They will remain outside the building with a designated chaperone until they are picked up in the parking lot.
<b>Lobby</b>	We are strictly eliminating social lingering in the lobby.
<b>Parents</b>	Parents are encouraged to drop off school-age students or remain in their car during classes. Pre-school students may have one adult enter the building with them. We encourage payments to be made via phone or through your Customer Portal.
